



Contest Rules & Regulations

1. For a donation of \$10 per ball or \$25 per set of 3 balls, each participant will be entered into the “OLA Golf Ball Drop”, scheduled for August 7, 2008, held at the Mallard Creek Golf Course in Columbia Station, Ohio. Participants may enter more than once and will be assigned one numbered golf ball per donation. A maximum of 400 golf balls will be sold. Winner need not be present.
2. On Thursday, August 7, 2008 at 3:00 p.m., the sold golf balls will be placed randomly in a container and flown in a helicopter and dropped above a pre-selected, make-shift hole at Mallard Creek Golf Course in Columbia Station, Ohio.
3. The participant whose golf ball goes in the hole will win \$1,000. If, in the event, that more than one ball goes into the hole, the cash prize will be split equally. If no ball goes into the hole, the participant with the golf ball that has landed closest to the hole will win. A measurement will be held and the closest ball to the hole, measured perpendicularly from the center of the hole, will win the prize. The ball measurement will be determined by three (3) judges selected by the Ohio Landscape Association. In the event of a tie, the winners will split the payout equally.
4. Furthermore, three (3) additional balls will be measured from the center of the hole in receding order in the event the first place prizewinner does not claim his/her prize.
5. The winner will be announced at the OLA Scholarship Golf Classic on August 7, 2008 and need not be present to win. If the winner cannot be located or fails to claim their prize within 30 days after notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.
6. If some unforeseen event (i.e. adverse weather) occurs that prevents the OLA Golf Ball Drop event from taking place as outlined above, the cash prizewinner will be determined by random drawing. Four numbers will be drawn from a random number generating device. The first number generated will win the \$1,000 cash prize. If the winner cannot be located or fails to claim their prize within 30 days after notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.
7. Ball purchases are non-refundable and all proceeds from the OLA Golf Ball Drop will benefit the OLA Scholarship Fund.
8. By participating, each participant releases, discharges, indemnifies, and holds harmless the Ohio Landscape Association and its respective officers, directors, employees, agents, event sponsors, and representatives from any and all liability, loss, harm, injury, damage, cost and expense whatsoever arising directly or indirectly from participation with the OLA Golf Ball Drop.
9. **All federal, state and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the individual winner.**
