Landscape Industry Certified-Technician — What Is It?

The international Landscape Industry Certified Technician program is an important part of any landscape company. Landscape contractors, supervisors, crew leaders / foremen, and field technicians who are certified are recognized internationally as qualified professionals. This can mean better wages and enhanced profits as the public becomes more aware of the value of doing business with a Landscape Industry Certified Technician.

This test was first developed by the California Landscape Contractors Association in 1983. In 1994, the Associated Landscape Contractors of America (ALCA), now known as PLANET purchased the rights to the test and began to license state associations to administer the test in their home state.

In Ohio, the Ohio Nursery and Landscape Association (ONLA), the Ohio Landscape Association (OLA), and The Ohio State University Agricultural Technical Institute (ATI) have partnered to administer the test.

The Test

This test is a hands-on test based on international standards. It recognizes proficiency in a wide range of skills in landscape installation, maintenance and irrigation, plus related safety issues.

The Test Site

Our permanent test site was constructed and is maintained at the Ohio State University Agricultural Technical Institute (Ohio State ATI) in Wooster. It was developed as collaboration among industry professionals primarily with donated resources.

Our 3-acre site has become a premier site for this internationally recognized test. In order to continue to grow this program, alterations and additions need to be made to the test site each year.
